TRU (CONT'D)

She's <u>really</u> right.

MICHAEL

Leave me alone.

They turn right onto --

EXT. STOP-N-SHOP BLOCK -- CONTINUOUS (3RD REDO DAY) 40

He finally blows.

MICHAEL

His eyes flick up and see the Stop-N-Shop. He turns to Tru.

MICHAEL (CONT'D)
